Mobilizing Directors for Climate Action, 20-21 June

About the event

Between June 20–21, the Climate Governance Initiative and World Economic Forum held a joint event called 'Mobilizing Directors for Climate Action' at the World Economic Forum headquarters in Geneva, Switzerland.

The event brought together 30–40 board directors from around the world who are already well known for their leadership on climate to discuss how to catalyse boardroom leadership on climate change. Many of the attendees are members of Climate Governance Initiative Chapters.

In the wake of <u>research from the Climate</u> <u>Governance Initiative</u> that only a third of board directors globally see climate as a high priority in their boardrooms, why should boards care about climate and sustainability?

The board directors we spoke to pointed to a variety of reasons, like:

lowering a company's cost of capital
providing certainty to investors and employees

•extending their competitive advantage over other businesses

•mitigating physical climate risks that impact the business' supply chain
